  - Pharisees
  - The Rich Man (Chapter 10:17-22)
  - Bartimaeus
  - Widow (Chapter 12:41-44)
  - Judas
  - Pilate
  - High Priest

- Describe three parables Jesus told.
- What does it mean, Peter denies Jesus. Why did Peter deny Jesus?
- Jesus last word on the cross was, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" Why do you think Jesus said this?
- Take a story in Mark and write a play, a story, draw or paint a picture that helps us understand the meaning of the story.
